*A*fton, established in 1885, was founded by settlers along the Lander cutoff of the Oregon Trail. This was the first government-built wagon road in the west; it is a 250-mile path first used by fur trappers in 1813 and is now on the National register of Historic places. Afton is an ideal destination for hiking, horseback, fishing, camping, and hunting. The main water supply is a cold water geyser, called Periodic Spring, that is the largest of only three known in the world and the only one in North America. The town proudly displays the world's largest elk horn arch, stretching 75 feet and consisting of over 3,000 elk antlers.
