

ALPINE AREA



Alpine is a small town located 37 miles south of Jackson Hole, Wyoming, emerging out of the Snake River Canyon and completely surrounded by mountains. Three rivers, the Grey's, the Snake and the Salt, converge and feed into the Palisades Reservoir, a recreational haven for boating, water skiing, ice fishing, and kayaking. Alpine attracts a harmonious blend of Jackson Hole commuters, entrepreneurs, and those seeking a second home in a place where wildlife and recreation abound. Currently, the elk population in Alpine's Elk Refuge outnumbers the residents in the winter months. A thriving retail, commercial and professional downtown district also offers proximity to some of the best fly-fishing, skiing and golfing in the area.
