

# THAYNE AREA



Thayne, Wyoming is considered the heart of Star Valley. It is surrounded by national forests and fed by seven mountain lakes, three major rivers and pure mountain springs, providing premier fishing opportunities for cutthroat trout, browns, brookies, rainbows and mackinaw. The surrounding forests are habitat to elk, moose, mule deer, bear, and bird life. Snow lovers will appreciate the average winter snow depth of three feet. This community, named after postmaster Henry Thayne, is still home of the areas first horse cutter/chariot races.
